His practice Greater Western Urology also covers general urological procedures including vasectomy, circumcision and operations/procedures for scrotal pathology and urinary continence.

Dr Bala Indrajit is a senior clinical lecturer at University of Sydney, Rural School of Medicine. He has a great passion and interest in surgical education of his junior staff, the medical students and surgical registrars in training.
